

LOUNGE RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The Lounge Manager or Bartender on Duty has the authority to enforce the following Rules and Regulations by the Executive Board of Post 219.

- a. In compliance with the following regulations, service can be denied to any individual when deemed appropriate by the Lounge Manager or Bartender on Duty.**
- b. Only Members in good standing with a current Membership Card and Guests will be served in the Lounge.**
- c. Any Member or Guest who is deemed intoxicated and unable to control their behavior will be respectfully asked to leave the premises.**
- d. No profanity, loud, bolsterous conversations, arguments or vulgar language will be tolerated. Failure to comply may result in Member and or Guest to vacate the premises and may result in being barred from the Post as per rules outlined on first page of (ADMITTANCE INTO POST 219)**
- e. The Commander along with any Executive Board Member of Post 219 who witnesses any of the above must allow the Bar Manager or Bartender on duty to attempt to resolve the issue before becoming involved.**
- f. Post 219 is a Non Smoking facility. There is a area designated outside of the Building that has been provided for Smokers to use.**
- g. No One Under the age of 21 will be served or seated at the Bar.**
- h. Anyone 12 years of age or younger must leave the Lounge by 7:00 PM.**
- i. Anyone under Age 21 must leave the Lounge by 9:00 PM unless attending a function sponsored by the Legion Family of Post 219.**
- j. Post 219 Family Members my cash checks in the lounge up to \$50.00 per Check and up to \$100.00 per week at the discretion of the Bartender on Duty. Driver's License number and telephone number must be on all checks cashed.**
- k. Ten (10) Minutes prior to the start of a Regular Meeting, no more alcoholic beverages will be sold to those eligible to attend the meeting.**
- l. At the Commencement of the Meetings, eligible members MUST attend said meeting or leave the Post Building and its property.**
